

Women of Excellence Nomination Form 2016

AWARD CRITERIA

The Victor Chamber of Commerce is seeking nominations to honor the passion, vision, and commitment of exemplary women who live, work, go to school, volunteer and/or contribute significantly to the Victor community. Three women will be chosen in three categories and celebrated at the Fourth Annual Victor Chamber Annual Women of Excellence Dinner to be held on Thursday, March 10th, 2016.

The Victor Community is very proud of its Native American roots exemplified by Ganondagan, the Seneca historic site. To recognize this rich history, the Victor Chamber of Commerce is seeking nomination for women who demonstrate the qualities of "Jikohnsaseh" a founder of the Iroquois Confederacy.

Jikohnsaseh

Jikohnsaseh (Gi-GON-sah-seh) was instrumental in forming the Five Nations Confederacy, which was founded on the message of peace, health and justice and one that pre-dated the American constitution by 750 years. She had great vision and wisdom. Above all, Jikohnsaseh had a passion for her people to share peace and equal rights for all women. She inspired women who became instrumental in building the Iroquois Nations or Haudenosaunee (HO-dee-no-sau-nee).

The Victor Chamber is soliciting nominations for women who possess the qualities of Jikohnsaseh and who have demonstrated significant achievements and have made contributions locally. Please submit your nomination in one or more of the following categories for a woman who is in school, lives, works, or volunteers in Victor:

1. **The Student of Promise Award – Role Model**


This award celebrates a young woman age 15-25 who attends school or lives in Victor, is dedicated to education and reflects the characteristics of Jikohnsaseh while significantly contributing to the betterment of the Victor and surrounding communities. This student serves as a role model for other young women and will be able to demonstrate achievement in the areas of leadership, mentoring, activism, volunteerism and/or participation in community initiatives.

2. **The Lantern Award – Volunteerism/Lifetime Achievement**

This lifetime achievement award celebrates a woman who reflects the characteristics of Jikohnsaseh and has contributed significantly to the Victor community by volunteering and/or participating in community programs and initiatives. This woman serves as a role model for all women and demonstrates achievement in the areas of volunteerism, community activism, leadership and mentoring over an extended period of time.

3. **The Jikohnsaseh Woman of Excellence Award – Professional Achievement**

This award honors a woman who lives and/or works in Victor who embodies the characteristics of Jikohnsaseh and has reached a level of professional achievement that is impressive and/or has contributed significantly to her chosen career field. Victor micro-brewery servers pay it forward to Victor Hiking Trails

Employees at a local brewery have stepped up once again to donate a portion of their earnings to a Victor non-profit organization.

VICTOR — Employees at a local brewery have stepped up once again to donate a portion of their earnings to a Victor non-profit organization.

On Jan. 3, members of Victor Hiking Trails, Inc. received a \$630 donation from the servers at VB Brewery on School Street.

According to VHT Chairperson David Wright, micro-brewery owners Tom and Cath Bullinger have demonstrated their support for the community since opening two years ago, donating generously to many local organizations.

At the beginning of each quarter, servers decide which organization will benefit from a portion of their tips, said Wright. From Oct. 1 to Dec. 31, half of the money in their tip jar was designated to be given to Victor Hiking Trails.

“We just love the trails, especially for morning walks when you might hear a wild turkey,” said Rochelle Smith, the server who suggested VHT as last quarter’s recipient.

The check for \$630 was presented on Jan. 3 at the 160 School St. brewery. Wright expressed appreciation on behalf of VHT for the donation, and thanked VB’s servers — Tim Murphy, Brittany Fowler, Tracy McClure, Heather Webb, Rochelle Smith, Amar Oesterly, and Randy Reiss.

In 2015, VB Brewery “flight attendants” — so named because they serve flights of beer — donated \$700 in tips to benefit Safe Journey, a program of Resolve of Greater Rochester, Inc., which serves victims of domestic abuse and violence.

Other non-profits to receive gifts in 2014 and 2015 were Serenity House in Victor, Camp Good Days and Special Times, the family of slain Rochester police officer Daryl Pierson, Victor-Farmington Food Cupboard, Honor Flight Rochester, and cancer research.


