ORDER FOR PUBLIC HEARING TO ESTABLISH THE "DUTCH ROAD CORPORATION SEWER DISTRICT" AND CONSOLIDATE IT INTO THE VICTOR CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Victor ("the Town") has received a Map, Plan and Report (the "MPR") requesting an extension to the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District (the "Sewer District") into two parcels, including a parcel at 788 Old Dutch Road, tax account # 14.02-01-1.211, and as well as a portion of a parcel at tax account # 14.00-01-51.1 (the proposed extension to the Sewer District is hereinafter referred to as the "Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District"); and

WHEREAS, given the nature of the MPR and the policy and practice of the Town of Victor with respect to sewer districts, the MPR will be treated as and has been converted to one for the establishment and consolidation of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, simultaneous with its establishment, the Town of Victor will cause the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District to be consolidated into the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District, so as to eliminate the additional administrative burden and costs associated with the operation of multiple sewer districts; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District comprise a parcel at 788 Old Dutch Road, tax account # 14.02-01-1.211, and as well as a portion of a parcel at tax account # 14.00-01-51.1, the specific metes and bounds legal description being set forth in the MPR referred to herein and available for public inspection at the Victor Town Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements include: infrastructure, including an 8 inch sanitary sewer main as well as a 4 inch lateral; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount proposed to be expended by the Town for the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District and associated improvements is the sum of zero dollars (\$0.00), as the applicant will pay for the capital cost thereof; and

WHEREAS, since there will be no capital cost to the Town for the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District, no financing will be employed and it is therefore not necessary to obtain the approval of the New York State Comptroller's Office; and

WHEREAS, simultaneous with the establishment of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District, it shall be consolidated into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District as more fully described in the "Proposed Joint Consolidation Agreement for the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District and the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District," (the "Agreement") adopted by the Victor Town Board on December 14, 2015; and

WHEREAS, a descriptive summary of the Agreement follows:

The current Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District and the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District (as proposed and described in the MPR referred to herein) will be consolidated so that the area and infrastructure of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District is added and consolidated into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District. The consolidation will eliminate the annual need for additional expenses in the administrative

oversight of multiple sewer districts. The existing debt of the Victor Consolidated Sewer District will be spread across the newly consolidated Victor Consolidated Sewer District. This consolidation will not be effective unless and until the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District is fully established in compliance with NY Town Law.

And, WHEREAS, after establishment and consolidation into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District, the capital cost to the typical residential property will be approximately \$78.24, annually, and the capital cost to the typical commercial property will be approximately \$376.30, annually, and the capital cost to those properties added into the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District by operation of this action (i.e., those properties within the area formerly referred to as the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District) will be in accordance with the formula established by the Town Board as set forth in the Victor Town Code at Chapter 162, and this action will not significantly change the costs for residential or commercial properties; and

WHEREAS, maintenance and operation charges will be calculated as more specifically set forth in the Victor Town Code at Chapter 162; and

WHEREAS, a hook-up fee will be charged in accordance with Chapter 162 of the Victor Town Code; and

WHEREAS, the MPR describing the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District, and the Agreement, are both on file in the office of the Town Clerk where they are available for public inspection; now, therefore be it

ORDERED and RESOLVED, that, pursuant to Article 12 of the Town Law, the Town Board of the Town of Victor, shall meet at the Town Hall, 85 East Main Street, Victor, New York, on the 8th day of February, 2016, at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the proposal to create the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District as well as the simultaneous consolidation of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District into the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District, at which time and place all persons interested in the subjects thereof may be heard; and be it further

ORDERED and RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes and directs the Town Clerk to duly publish and post a copy of this Order in the official Town newspaper, on the bulletin board in the office of said Town Clerk, and on the Town website not less than ten (10) days before and not more than twenty (20) days before the public hearing date as is required by Town Law and complete or arrange for the securing of Affidavits of Publication of Notice and Affidavits of Posting Notice of Public Hearing.

RESOLVED that the Victor Town Board hereby approves Release No. 2 (Final) on the Five Star Bank Irrevocable Letter of Credit No. 70020417701 in the amount of \$68,042.76 minus engineering and inspection fees and any other fees owed the Town as recommended by the Town Engineer; and, further

RESOLVED that given said release there now remains \$0.00 in said Letter of Credit after acceptance of the dedicated facilities in accordance with the Town Engineer's letter dated January 29, 2016; and, further

RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Engineer for the Town, MCA Group LLC Inc., and BME Associates.

WHEREAS, the Town of Victor (the "Town") has received a Map, Plan and Report (the "MPR"), requesting an extension to the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District (the "Sewer District") into two parcels, including a parcel at 788 Old Dutch Road, tax account # 14.02-1-1.211, and as well as a portion of a parcel at tax account # 14.00-1-51.100 (the proposed extension to the Sewer District is hereinafter referred to as the "Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District"); and

WHEREAS, given the nature of the MPR and the policy and practice of the Town of Victor with respect to sewer districts, the MPR will be treated as and has been converted to one for the establishment and consolidation of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, after the said MPR was duly filed in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Victor (where it was then and is currently available for public inspection), the Town Board did duly adopt an Order and Resolution (the "Order") reciting the proposed establishment of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District and a description of the boundaries of the proposed Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District, the maximum amount proposed to be expended for the improvement, that amount being zero dollars (\$0.00), the proposed method of apportioning the cost of such improvement, and the proposed method of financing to be employed, the fact that a map, plan and report describing the same are on file in the Town Clerk's Office for public inspection, and specifying that the Town Board shall meet at the Town Hall, 85 East Main Street, Victor, New York, on the 8th day of February, 2016, for the purposes of conducting a public hearing on the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District establishment and consolidation, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the Order additionally specified that the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District, simultaneous with the establishment thereof, is to be consolidated into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District, and said Order set forth a descriptive summary of the Proposed Joint Consolidation Agreement for the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District and the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District (the "Agreement"), as well as the costs to typical properties, including fees; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Order were duly published and posted according to law, and said Town Board did, at the time and place specified in said Order, duly meet and consider such proposal and heard all persons interested in the subject thereof, who appeared at such time and place, concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the evidence offered at such time and place requires that the Town Board make the determinations hereinafter made, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Order for the notice of the public hearing was duly published and posted as required by law and is otherwise sufficient; and be it further

RESOLVED, that all property and property owners within the proposed Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District are benefitted; and be it further

RESOLVED, that all property and property owners benefitted by the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District are included within the limits thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Victor, in the County of Ontario, that it is in the public interest of the Town of Victor to authorize the establishment of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District and the simultaneous consolidation thereof into the Victor Consolidated Sewer District; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby approve and authorize the establishment of the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District as well as the simultaneous consolidation thereof into the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District pursuant to the Agreement, said Agreement now and hereby adopted by the Town Board as the Final Consolidation Agreement for the Town of Victor Consolidated Sewer District and the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the capital costs charged to the properties within the Victor Consolidated Sewer District, as consolidated with the Dutch Road Corporation Sewer District, will be in accordance with the formula established by the Town Board as set forth in the Victor Town Code at Chapter 162; and be it further

RESOLVED, that maintenance and operation charges will be calculated and charged as more specifically set forth in the Victor Town Code at Chapter 162; and be it further

RESOVLED, that a hook-up fee will be charged in accordance with Chapter 162 of the Victor Town Code; and be it further

RESOLVED, that inasmuch as no expenditure of funds for capital costs is authorized herein, and because the Town will not expend any monies for the establishment indicated herein, this Resolution is not subject to the review and/or approval of the State Comptroller of the State of New York; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this constitutes a Type II action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and is thus not subject to review under the same; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the applicant is directed to provide to the Town Clerk current maps showing parcel boundaries and assessment districts and areas, in both hard copy and digital form for the Clerk to submit to the Ontario County Real Property Office and the Town Assessor; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Victor shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be duly filed with the New York State Comptroller; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk publish and post a Notice of Permissive Referendum within 10 days of adoption of this resolution in accordance with Town Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Victor shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be duly recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Ontario County within ten (10) days of the adoption of this Resolution.
