

National Trails Day® is a celebration of trails that evolved from the report of President Ronald Reagan's President's Commission on Americans Outdoors. In 1987, the report recommended that all Americans be able to go out their front doors and within fifteen minutes, be on trails that wind through their cities or towns and bring them back without retracing steps. The recommendation, dubbed Trails for All Americans, became the impetus behind several public and private parties joining American Hiking Society in launching National Trails Day® in 1993.

Trails do not just appear for our enjoyment. It takes many hours of planning, labor, and negotiating to develop them. National Trails Day®, the only nationwide celebration of trails, brings awareness to trails and thanks many people and partners for their support and hard work, including volunteers, land agencies, and outdoor minded businesses. It is also a day to introduce people to the many joys and benefits of trails.


# NTD 2016

This year we are celebrating the opening of two new facilities near the Hamlet of Fishers, New York. Victor Hiking Trails, Inc. (VHT) works very closely with the Parks and Recreation Department of the Town of Victor. This year's NTD events will be centered out of the new Parks & Rec Center, 7891 Lehigh Crossing, Victor off of Wangum Rd (CR 42).

The new Parks and Rec Center is on the connecting trail between Fishers Park to the north and the Lehigh Trail to the south. The facility is designed with flexible space to accommodate all sorts of physical activities as well as family and/or community gatherings such as the VHT 2016 NTD event.

- Nat Fisher Memorial Bridge – Fishers Park – Final design and approval phase – over \$4,000 donated by friends and family of Nat toward the \$7,800 budget – [won grant from American Hiking Society for \\$2,500 – Yeah!!](#)
- George Heltz Fish Creek Bridge Eagle Project – Auburn Trail East Victor – Final design complete, permits have been submitted to DEC & ACE and now in final approval phase – has raised over \$5,000 toward the \$6,000 project

- Daniel Waltman – 150' boardwalk in Lehigh Crossing Park – met with Parks & Rec – checking on need for approval from Town, DEC & ACE – [had ADK retiree clearing crew clear basic trail 6/1](#)
- [Domine Trail System – added new trail along eastern border with Pinnacle – working on bench cutting some portions as this sheet is handed around the table today](#)
- [Extended Omnitech Trail with 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance near Best Western](#)






