Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

The next time you visit Victor Municipal Park, be sure to take your volleyball, bocce ball set or horseshoes! In accord with the master plan for that facility, we recently constructed dedicated spaces for these activities. This spring and summer we also expanded the parking area at Victor Municipal Park, re-surfaced the parking areas at Fisher Park and installed "new" tennis court fencing at Fishers Park. These projects were funded by our Capital Parks Improvement fund.

We are working with the Town of Perinton Department of Public Works on the Woolston Road shoulder widening project which is part of the Auburn Trail Extension project. This portion of the project will take trail users to Powder Mill Park. In 2014, the Department in cooperation with Victor Hiking Trails, Genesee Regional Off-Road Cyclists, our Town Historian Babette Huber and members of the Rochester Birding Association will craft the interpretive features for our community valued trail! We are also eagerly anticipating the expansion of the Auburn Trail to the east through the Towns of Farmington and Canandaigua who recently completed their feasibility study and are in the process of seeking project funding.

Activities and events that you can look forward to this fall include several new day trips and outings for our senior citizens including the *Pike Stained Glass Studio*, the *Naples Grape Festival* and a *"Tuesday Lunch and Travelogue Series."* Our fall special events include the Jack-O-Lantern Trail and the Halloween *"Trunk or Treat."* We would like to thank the many individuals and organizations that donated items through the Town for the Victor Farmington Food Cupboard at our concerts this summer. We appreciate the support of the Victor Garden Club and the Victor Village Cemetery Committee for helping us beautify our public spaces. In conclusion, we value your participation in our recreation programs and your support in promoting the quality of life in Victor.
