Moving? Cleaning out your attic or garage? Redecorating? Looking for an item? Just have good useable items you no longer want or need? The Town of Victor offers residents another option to keep those useable items out of the landfill. It's called a Swap Shop.

The purpose of the Swap Shop is to encourage waste reduction through the practice of reuse. The goal is to divert good, useable items away from the waste stream and to reduce the Town's landfill costs.

Here's how the Swap Shop works. Residents having items in working, useable condition donate them to the Swap Shop. Residents in need of items visit the Swap Shop looking for the items. If the items are available,

they take them. "Swapping" extends both the life of the items and the life of the landfill.

Reducing and Reusing Basics (US EPA Website)

The most effective way to reduce waste is to not create it in the first place.

Making a new product requires a lot of materials and energy - raw materials must be extracted from the earth, and the product must be fabricated then transported to wherever it will be sold.

As a result, reduction and reuse are the most effective ways you can save natural resources, protect the environment and save money.

Rules - Open to Victor Residents Only

PICK-UP: Open to Victor Residents WITH Transfer Station Permit or FREE Swap Shop Sticker during Swap Shop hours ONLY

DROP-OFF: Open to Victor Residents WITH Transfer Station Permit or FREE Swap

Shop Sticker during Swap Shop hours ONLY

PARKING LIMIT: 15 minutes per visit / 30 minutes per day - NO LOITERING

VOLUNTEERS: Visitors to Swap Shop MUST follow directions of volunteers

ALL ITEMS available on FIRST COME / FIRST SERVED basis

ALL ITEMS ARE FREE

DEALERS are NOT Permitted to use the Swap Shop to obtain inventory



Acceptable Items

All items must be clean and in good working condition or easily repairable:

- * Toys / Games
- * Bicycles / Exercise Equipment / Sporting Goods (golf clubs, skis, skates, etc.)
- * Household Items: kitchenware, pots and pans, small appliances, canning jars, curtains, linens, baskets, etc.
- * Household Electric Items: lamps, fans, dehumidifiers, humidifiers, phones, etc.
- * Decorative Items: knick knacks, art, handcrafts, holiday items
- * Baby Items
- * Tools / Hardware
- * Garden / Yard / Outdoor: hand & power tools, supplies, grills, decorative items, outdoor furniture, mowers (without gas), etc.
- * Office Furniture / Supplies
- * Furniture: Must be in good condition - large furniture is dependent upon space.
- * Entertainment Items: videos, DVD's, CD's, records, radios, stereos, VCR's, CD/DVD players. *(MUST WORK)*
- * Books
- * Plants
- * Windows / Doors

Unacceptable Items

- NO TVs / Computer Equipment / Monitors
- NO Baby Cribs
- NO Mattresses or Box Springs
- NO Encyclopedias, Textbooks or Magazines
- NO Clothing
- NO Stuffed Animals
- NO Bed Pillows
- NO Large Appliances: stoves, refrigerators, etc.
- NO Paints / Solvents / Chemicals
- NO Tires
- NO Food / Perishable Items
- NO Propane Tanks
- NO Batteries
- NO Weapons
- NO Construction Debris
- NO Household Trash
