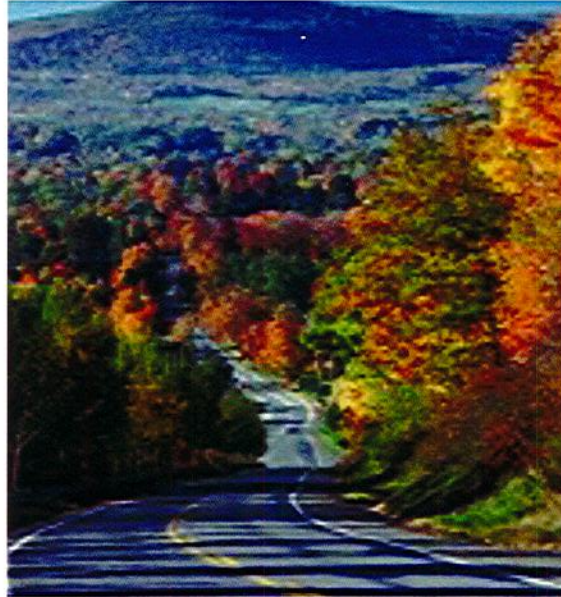
Citizens Academy Program
