WHEREAS, the Town Board (the "Town Board") of the Town of Victor (the "Town") identified the need to update the Comprehensive Plan as a result of the Town of Victor's growth and change since the adoption of the 1995 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Village of Victor, the Town Board formed the Comprehensive Plan Committee and charged it with creating a new, up to date Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, with much public input and with much time and effort, the Comprehensive Plan Committee has recommended to the Town of Victor a draft Comprehensive Plan to replace the current 1995 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, said draft Comprehensive Plan ("Comprehensive Plan") is now on file with the Victor Town Clerk where it is available for examination and review by the public; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with development of the Comprehensive Plan, the Town has developed a draft Agricultural and Farmland Protection Plan, which is a component of the draft Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, said draft Agricultural Farmland Protection Plan is now on file with the Victor Town Clerk where it is available for examination and review by the public (the Comprehensive Plan and Agricultural Plan hereinafter referred to as the "Action"); and

WHEREAS, as Lead Agency pursuant to SEQR, the Town Board adopted a positive declaration with regard to the Action on June 22, 2015; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to SEQR, a draft generic environmental impact statement ("DGEIS") was submitted to the Town Board with respect to the Action; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed the DGEIS in order to determine the adequacy of the DGEIS pursuant to SEQR; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Victor hereby determines that the Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement is adequate for public review and directs that a notice of completion of the DGEIS be prepared, filed and published on its behalf as required in 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 617 State Environmental Quality Review; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Victor Planning Board hereby establishes a public comment period of thirty (30) calendar days beginning on Wednesday, June 24, 2015, the date of the first filing and circulation of the notice of completion, and ending on Friday, July 24, 2015; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a combined public hearing for the Comprehensive Plan, the DGEIS, and the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Plan, pursuant to both the SEQR Regulations and Town Law Section 272-a, be duly noticed and held on Monday, July 13, 2015; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement will be available for public review in the Victor Town Clerk's Office, and copies may be obtained through the Victor Town Clerk's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is authorized to execute such necessary documents and to take such other actions as will facilitate an orderly and proper SEQR process; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be provided to all interested and involved agencies.
