Adopt Local Law #01-21 to Override the Tax Levy Limit for the Village Fiscal Year 2021-2022

On motion of Trustee XX, seconded by Trustee XX the following resolution was ADOPTED X AYES X NAYS

Whereas, a resolution was adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Victor for a public hearing to be held by said Board of Trustees on March 1, 2021 at 7:00pm via zoom meeting and live streamed on YouTube to hear all interested parties on a proposed Local Law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c; and

Whereas, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the official newspaper of the Village of Victor, on February 18, 2021 and all other notices required by law to be given were properly served, posted or given; and

Whereas, said public hearing was held on March 1, 2021 at 7:00pm via zoom meeting and live streamed on YouTube and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said Proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees on the Village of Victor, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Village of Victor to adopt said Local Law.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Victor hereby adopts said Local Law No. 1-21 of 2021, entitled, "A Local Law of override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution, and e it further

Resolved, that the Village Clerk be and she hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and give due notice of the adoption of said local law to the Secretary of State of New York.

Local Law #1-21

A local law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c

Section 1. Legislative Intent It is the intent of this local law to allow, but not require, the Village of Victor to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2021 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes the village's board of trustees to override the property tax levy limit for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said village board of trustees.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override The Board of Trustees of the Village of Victor, County of Ontario, is hereby authorized, but not required, to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2021 that includes a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Severability If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
