

Tree Board Mtg Notes – 2/14/22

Discussion:

1. Park Bench – Regina reported that Mike has not done any further work due to cold weather. He will keep us up to date as he resumes work on it.
2. Tree Inventory Status – The village has procured an accurate GPS system that will serve as the check for accuracy of the data currently reflected in our inventory. A field check with this new system was done this week that shows many of our tree's location data is not of sufficient accuracy. John Turner is suggesting that we use "Diamond Maps" as the system for our tree data. It appears to have the same functionality as the current MRB system at a fraction of the cost and the information can be retrieved by phone or laptop in the field. LeiAnna has been working with Sean(Village DPW) and will be in a position to share details at our next meeting.
3. Tree City USA – The village has been approved for year 2021. An online recognition event will take place on 3/17. B. Haggett will be attending.
4. Request for Review of Landscape Plans for Farm Store – The group reviewed the architectural plans for the

planned Farm Store on West Main St. The only point of concern identified was possible visual obstruction with the two red maple trees at the entrance/exit onto Main St.

5. Victor Voice Article – The article for the Spring/Summer edition will be generated by Gene and reviewed by Ruth, LeiAnna and Regina. The article will share our plans for the 2022 Arbor Day and invite the community to participate.
