Meeting was called to order by Mayor Hadden at 7:00pm.

Privilege of the Floor

Chris Thomas, Twin Elder Brewery, came before the board to field any question/concerns the board may have regarding his proposed car shows he wants to hold at his 75 Coville St. location.

Mr. Thomas stated these car shows will be the same as they were at 160 School St. He explained the show on May 28 will be a bike show, but all the others will be cars and bikes.

Mr. Crowley is concerned about the bike only show being in the residential neighborhood that he is now in.

Mr. Thomas has secured a liquor license from the State Liquor Authority that states outside drinking is allowed.

Mayor Hadden is concerned about the parking. Mr. Thomas has spoken with the owners of the neighboring businesses to use their parking lots. Mayor Hadden would like the neighboring owners and Mr. Thomas to have written agreements regarding their approval for the parking. Mr. Thomas stated most of the cars are in the car show, not a lot of spectators only vehicles.

Mr. Thomas stated there will be outside music during the shows, but is mindful of the neighbors regarding the noise level.
