Director of Public Works Report

- Drainage replacement on Woodworth will be done this week
- Moore Ave starting this week, milling on May 10
- Town fueling station has some issues, using Farmington Highway Dept.

Trustees Reports

Carol Commisso – Meeting with Kathy Rayburn regarding the Revitalization Plan.

Michelle Chalupa – Attended Library Board meeting. They will be starting two meetings a month due to the new Library project. The library will be hosting FAQ zoom meetings regarding the Library budget and tax rate. Arbor Day was on Sat. May 1 in Mead Park. Ms. Chalupa drafted a letter to Source Power regarding phone calls they are making to residents. These calls are to get residents to sign up for Community Solar. Ms. Chalupa has insisted, on behalf of the Village Board, that the calls stop immediately. The Village Board will work with Roctricity to use a different approach to get the word out about Community Solar.

Robert Kelly – At Planning Board, a site plan and sign was approved for Village Motors, 223 W. Main St. The budget vote for the Library is on May 18.

Michael Crowley – Mr. Crowley would like two abandoned homes on W. Main St. addressed.

Mayor Report

Mayor Hadden reported:

- Distributed the scope of work for the Victor Street Connectivity Plan which is an extension of the Access Management Plan. The Town is initiating this project.
- A festival permit has been submitted for Hang Around Victor Day. LDC and the Chamber are working on a COVID plan for the event. Ms. Rayburn and Ms. DiPrima have requested to come to the May 17 meeting with information.

- Read a note from a School St. resident thanking the Board for our Large Trash collection service.
- Mayor Hadden has spoken to residents inquiring as to how they feel about the new Marijuana law. It is his understanding that someone is interested in opening a cannabis shop in the Village. This businessman will be attending the May 17 meeting to provide more detailed information regarding this type of business.

The board had a short discussion regarding this legislation and their concerns.
