# COVID-19 Resources for Ontario County Businesses



## RESTAURANT REVITALIZATION FUND

The American Rescue Plan Act established the Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) to provide qualifying restaurants with funding equal to their pandemic-related revenue loss up to \$10 million per business and no more than \$5 million per physical location.

The application process began on May 3, 2021.



## SHUTTERED VENUE OPERATORS GRANT

This is a U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) program for operators of live venues, live performing arts organizations, museums and movie theatres, as well as live venue promoters, theatrical producers and talent representatives to apply for critical economic relief, as those eligible entities are some of the first that had to shutter their doors a year ago in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The application process began on April 8, 2021 on a first-in, first-out basis.



## ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN

Those who received a partial EIDL Advance and are located in a low-income community may have received an invitation to apply for the Targeted EIDL Advance. To qualify, small businesses must:

- Be located in a designated low-income community
- Be able to show more than a 50% economic loss during an eight-week period beginning on March 2, 2020
- Have 10 or fewer employees

Applications are currently being accepted from all qualified small businesses and private nonprofit organizations.



## PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM

PPP is open to sole proprietors and subcontractors, as well as small businesses with employees. The deadline for submission is May 31, 2021. **If you file a Schedule C with your tax returns, contact your local SBDC or SBA lender to learn more.**

The application deadline is May 31, 2021.
