

# COMPOSTING WITH IMPACT EARTH®



## STEP ONE:



Pick up your organics bucket from the Town of Victor Recycling Center!

Bring it home, and place it in an easily accessible area, we suggest in a corner of your kitchen or by your trash and recycling receptacles.

## STEP TWO:



Fill up your bucket with food scraps: vegetable trimmings, leftover food, meat, bones, and dairy.

You can also place any paper products like paper towels and napkins, and products that are labeled compostable in your bucket!

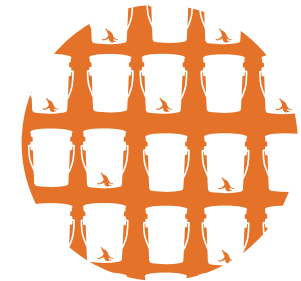
## STEP THREE:



Using your transfer station permit, bring your full bucket back to the Recycling Center every week when the Center is open.

You will drop off your full bucket and pick up a clean, new one to bring home with you!

## STEP FOUR:



Where does your organics go? We bring all materials collected to one of our 5 partner farms in Monroe and Ontario County.

Our partner farms include vermicomposters, livestock ranches, and other compost processors.

**Our compost processors turn your compostable wastes into a nutrient rich soil amendment product. Once a year we provide a giveback of some of the compost soil that has been produced.**

### **Certified Compostable Products**

BPI Certified Plastics, Commercial Compostable Labeled  
Products (biopolymer products like cups, utensils)
